Definition of Prepared School
 A prepared school is the one that its risks are minimized, is capable of response against disasters, bears minimum losses and damages and can recover its efficiency in the shortest time.

Characteristics of a Prepared School
 Identification of hazards and having a Risk Reduction Plan for the school
 Preparing communication infrastructure for school for the purpose of participation of students' families and the emergency service organizations
 Having an educational calendar for the purpose of preparedness of school staff and students in case of emergency Providing preparedness and disaster response equipment


Virtual training including: Foundations of disaster management and passive defense, safety principles at school, mental support, successful experiences of disaster management
